

SCHOOL CALENDAR

The school operates under a 180-day calendar, divided into two semesters. The first semester begins in early August and concludes in mid-December; the second semester begins in early January and concludes in early June. The Secondary School operates under a weekly block schedule, with each class meeting for 70 minutes.

RIGOROUS ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

To help students prepare for and be successful at universities around the world, AISVN offers the IB Programme Continuum. 43% of students in grade 12 and 83% of students in grade 11 are currently pursuing the full IB Diploma. AISVN offers 23 IB subjects at standard and higher levels.

- The International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (IB PYP) is for students from Kham Pha to Grade 5.
- The International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IB MYP) is for students from Grade 6 to Grade 10
- The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IB DP) is for students from Grade 11 and Grade 12.

ENGLISH AS AN ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE

The American International School Vietnam is dedicated to fostering language growth within the classroom setting. Whether a student is fully proficient in English or in the developmental stages, teachers firmly believe that all students will learn and progress academically. Teachers understand that each subject area has its specialized language and work every day to develop that language with all students. Utilizing a co-planning immersion model with response to intervention techniques, our enhanced support program allows students to simultaneously acquire the English language while mastering content concepts. AISVN uses admissions testing and yearly monitoring of student progress as a tool to determine the level of scaffolding for each student within our program. Entry-level requirements are set so that all students can reasonably be prepared for and expected to succeed within our rigorous IB programme.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

26 credits are required for graduation. A minimum grade of 3 is required to receive credit for a course; the duration of each course is one year. To earn a diploma from AISVN, a student must attend the school for at least the full academic year in Grade 12. Students of Vietnamese nationality are required by the Vietnamese Ministry of Education and Training to complete a credit of Vietnamese Studies for each year in which they are enrolled.


Grade 12 students registered for full IB Diploma
